



ENVIRONMENTAL SAFETY CHECKLIST

1. Label hazardous materials and wastes properly?
2. Maintain good housekeeping procedures?
3. Maintain records on hazardous materials?
4. Inspect deliveries immediately and return unacceptable materials to suppliers?
5. Periodically inspect stored chemicals for signs of leakage, poor storage practices, and other problems?
6. Employing a "first in, first out" policy for raw materials to keep them from becoming too old to use?
7. Link purchasing requests into an inventory system so that excess chemicals in stock can be used before buying more?
8. Check that all containers have legible labels?
9. Substitute non-hazardous materials where possible?
10. Store containers to allow for visual inspection of corrosion and leaks?
11. Raise drums off the floor to prevent corrosion from leaks or sweating concrete?
12. Keep track of where spills occur so that you can take precautionary measures in the future?
13. Schedule regular cleaning and maintenance to prevent leaks, avoid product contamination, remove deposits and maintain process efficiency?
14. Use only small amounts of solvent to clean equipment?
15. Use spent/recovered solvents for an initial rinse and fresh solvents for a final rinse?
16. Is there a plan for spill reduction and collection in maintenance areas (such as the use of drip pans, secondary containment, and absorbent products)?
17. Properly store and handle hazardous materials?
18. Access to hazardous materials is limited?
19. Employees are trained to use as little solvent/thinner as possible?
20. The facility uses the least toxic cleaner/detergent necessary to effectively clean the aircraft?
